# Total Joint Replacement Surgery

## Visitors & Coaches: How to Get to the Hospital and Where to Park

Please follow the current visitor policy guidelines outlined at [overlakehospital.org/safe-in-our-care/visitor-notice](https://overlakehospital.org/safe-in-our-care/visitor-notice).

When you arrive at the Overlake Medical Center campus, follow signs to **park in Garage 3 (North Garage) or Garage 4 (West Garage)**.

*Parking for patients undergoing total joint replacement surgery will be covered by the parking pass, as outlined in the joint education presentation, in Garage 3 and Garage 4. At this time, Garage 1 is not included in this pass nor is parking validation provided.*

**After you park, go to the Admitting desk located in the Main Lobby.**

- If parked in Garage 3, take parking elevators to Level 1. Walk the first floor of Building 3 through the Main Lobby until you come to Admitting.
- If parked in Garage 4, take parking elevators to Level 1. Walk across the covered walkway to Building 3. Admitting will be on your left as you enter the building.

### **Directions to the new orthopedic unit (East 5) in Building 1:**

- Use Building 1 public elevators (on the map on the reverse side, these are labeled next to OB Emergency).
- Take the elevators to level 5.
- Exit the elevators and turn left to enter the East 5 corridor.
- All rooms are numbered. Please check in at the nursing station before visiting your loved one.

### **Directions to the same-day discharge recovery area (SP2) in Building 2:**

- Use Building 2 public elevators (on the map on the reverse side, next to Medical Imaging).
- Take the elevators to level 2.
- Exit the elevators and turn right to enter the perioperative corridor. Enter the family waiting area.
- Use the phone in the waiting area to dial extension 6009. A nursing staff member will let you into the recovery area.

When the patient is cleared for discharge, we will escort them to the Main Lobby where you can pick them up at either the entrance between Building 3 and Garage 4 (West Garage).
