#### **Recovery Rooms/East Tower**

For moms who have C-sections, the new East Tower offers dedicated recovery rooms where they can be closely supervised by expert obstetric nurses.

#### Patient Rooms/South Tower

The South Tower is connected to the new East Tower and offers contiguous units on floors 4 and 5. The South Tower was completed in 2009.

#### Universal Patient Rooms/East Tower

Most patient rooms in the new East Tower conform to a universal design that provides ample space for patients, family and caregivers. Universal rooms are found on floors 3 (mother and baby), four (heart and cancer) and five (orthopedics). Their design enables maximum flexibility for the future, when specific care units may be shifted or relocated to accommodate our patient population.

### Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) Rooms/East Tower

Located on the mother and baby floor of the new East Tower, additional NICU rooms keep babies in need of extra care close to their moms. Several rooms are built to accommodate two infants, ensuring that twins can be cared for in the same room. The spacious rooms ensure that family members can visit in comfort. A state-ofthe-art Angel Eye camera system is provided for each baby, enabling family to use a secure login and see their baby from anywhere. Additional NICU rooms are located in the West Tower.

#### **Critical Care Rooms/South Tower**

The pandemic has brought intensive care to the forefront of our minds. Overlake provides intensive care services on the third floor of the South Tower. The unit includes sophisticated, lifesaving equipment and highly trained and specialized staff.

#### Labor and Delivery Rooms/East Tower

The labor and delivery rooms in the East Tower (opened in February, 2021) are 90% larger than the rooms in our previous Childbirth Center. They are thoughtfully designed to provide plenty of space for family members and still give caregivers all the space they need to work.

## Comfort Care Rooms/East Tower

Floors four and five of the new East Tower each include two comfort care rooms. They are larger than our universal rooms and intended for individuals who need additional personal or equipment space.
