on Cath Lab 3 Renovation!

We're thrilled to share that the renovation of Catheterization (Cath) Lab 3 is officially underway! In May, our teams began the process of transforming this critical space to better serve our patients and staff. We expect to complete the project by mid-September.

The first phase focuses on deinstalling the existing equipment and launching major construction to bring the room up to current building standards. The new Philips C-arm imaging system, a key component of this upgrade, will be delivered and installed closer to the room's go-live date.

This project is a true collaboration across departments. Our engineering, infection prevention, and cath lab teams have worked hand-

in-hand with contractors to ensure every detail —from ceiling-mounted equipment weight to precise electrical layouts—is thoughtfully designed to meet our high standards for safety and care.

A cath lab (short for catheterization laboratory)

is a high-tech hospital room where doctors diagnose and treat heart conditions using minimally invasive procedures. It's equipped with advanced tools, including the C-arm, a special imaging device shaped like the letter "C."

The C-arm moves around the patient to capture real-time they need it most.

The theme, "We Grow Together," reflected the powerful partnership between Overlake and donors like you—whose support fuels innovation and ensures access to world-class healthcare for all.


